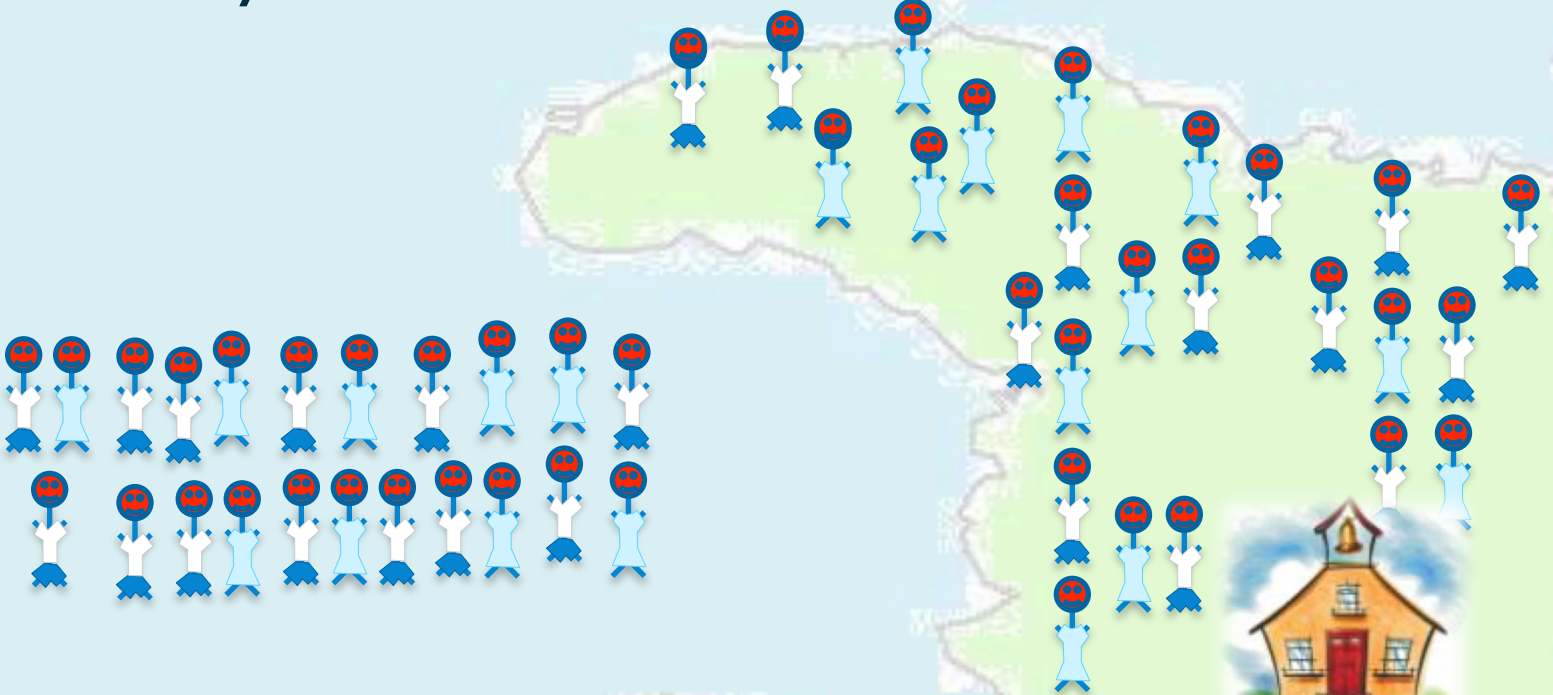

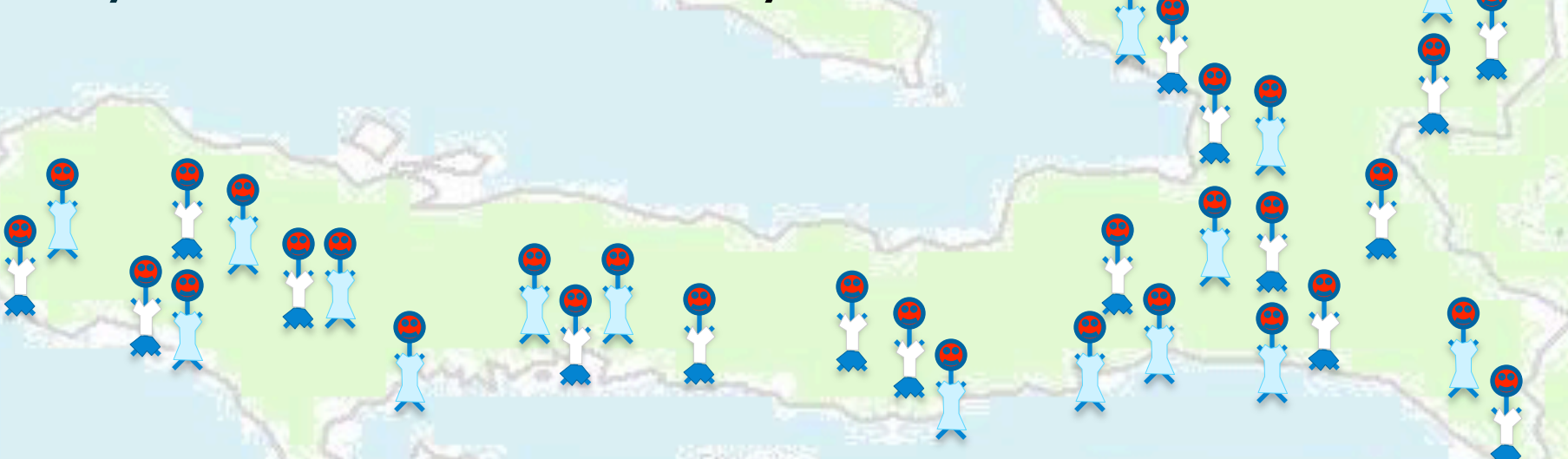

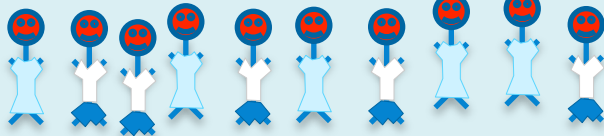

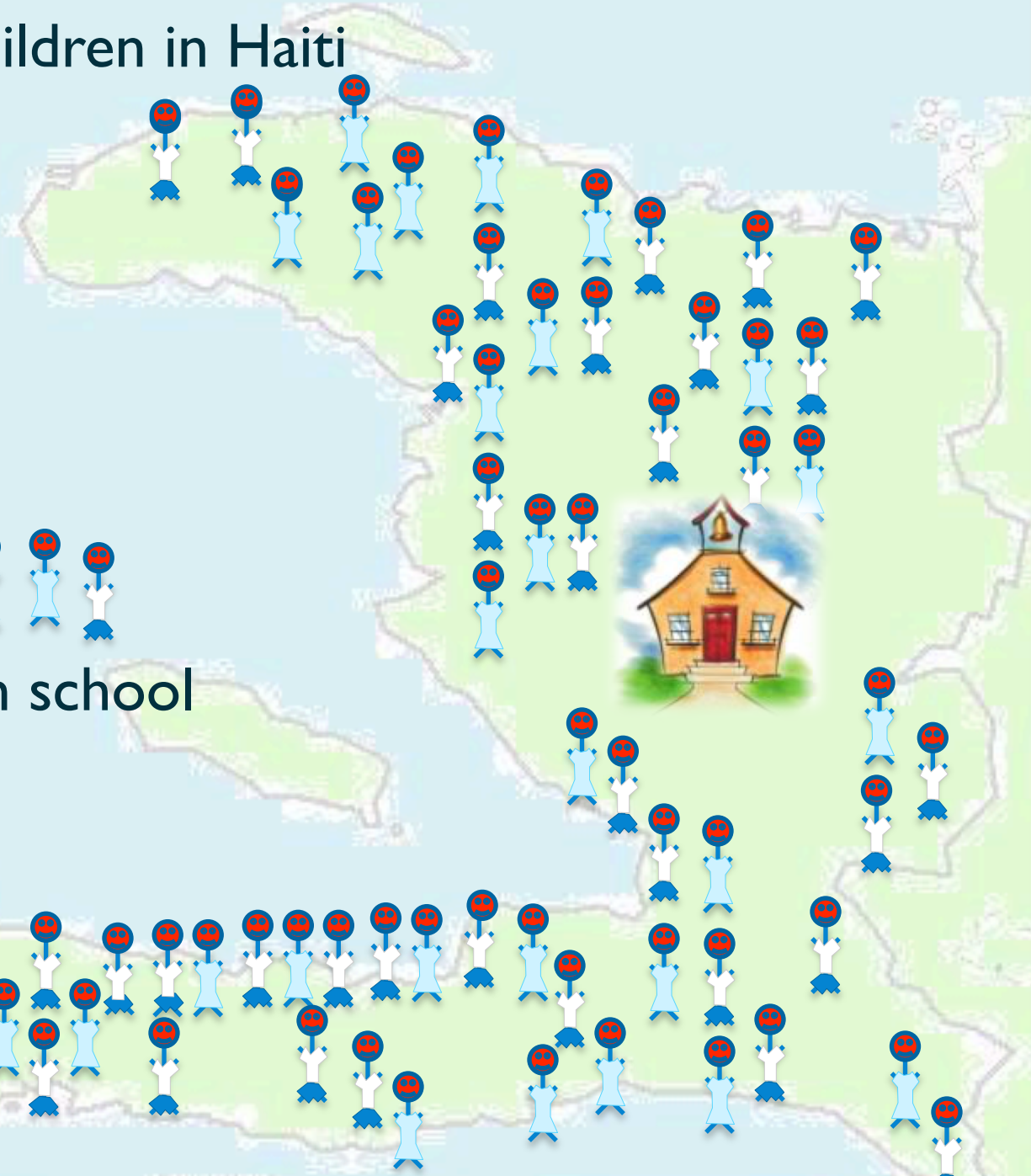
Only 22 will finish elementary school

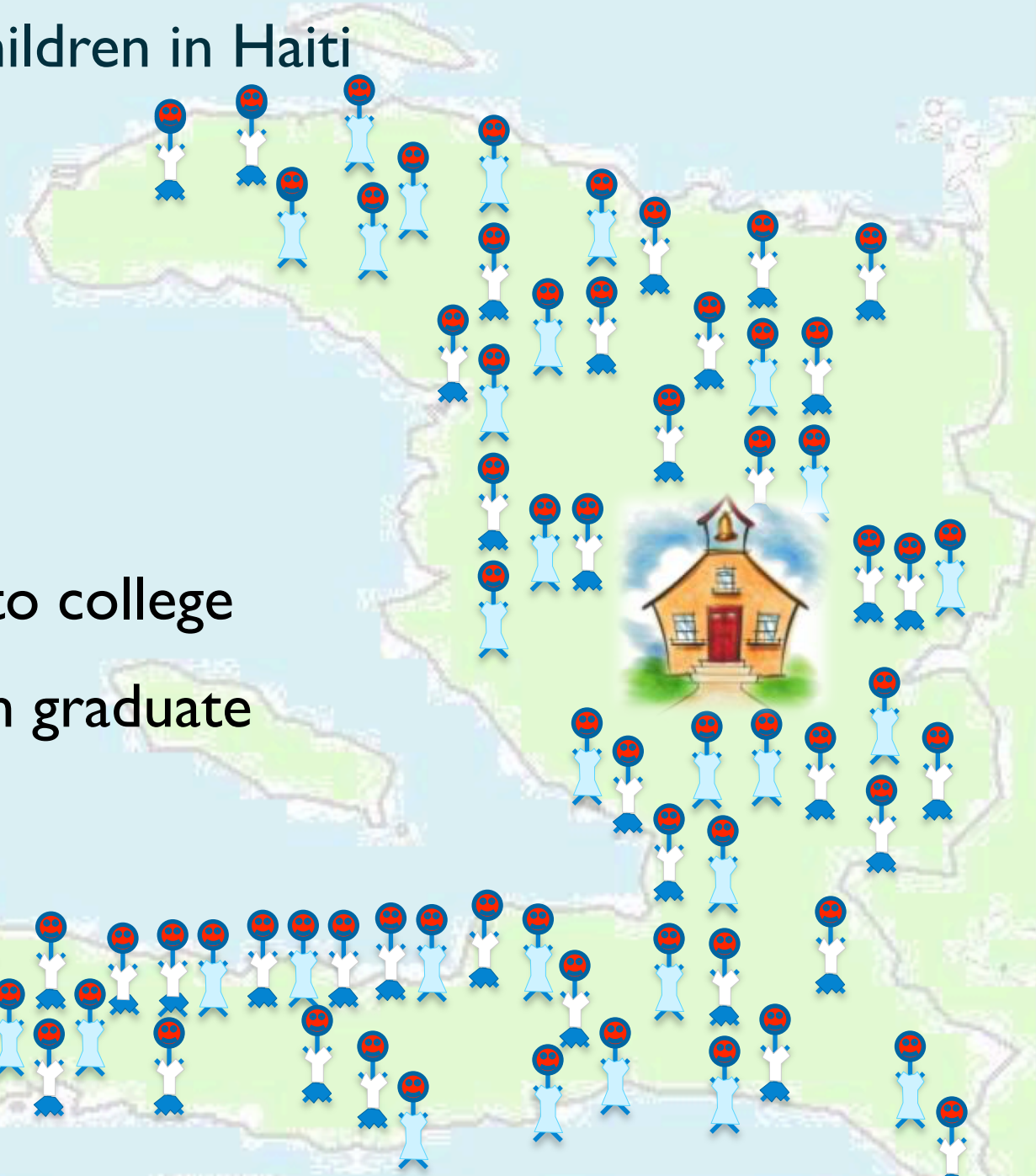

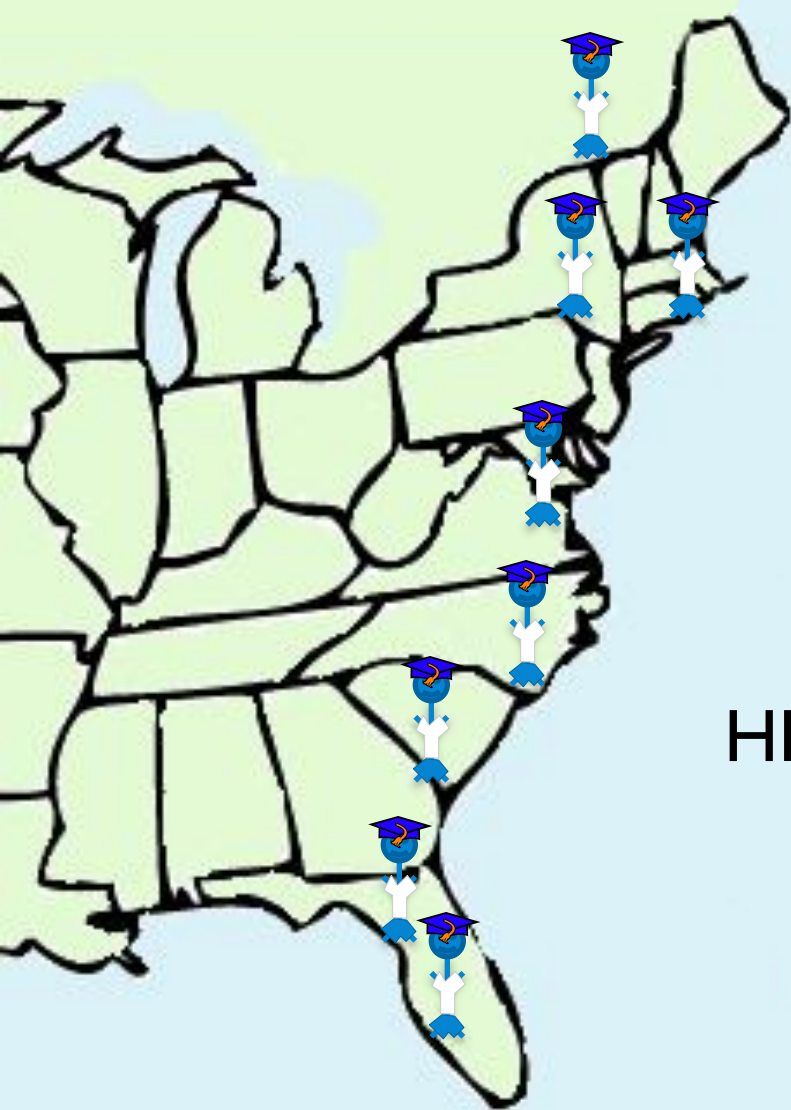
HAITI'S FUTURE DEPENDS ON HIGHER EDUCATION

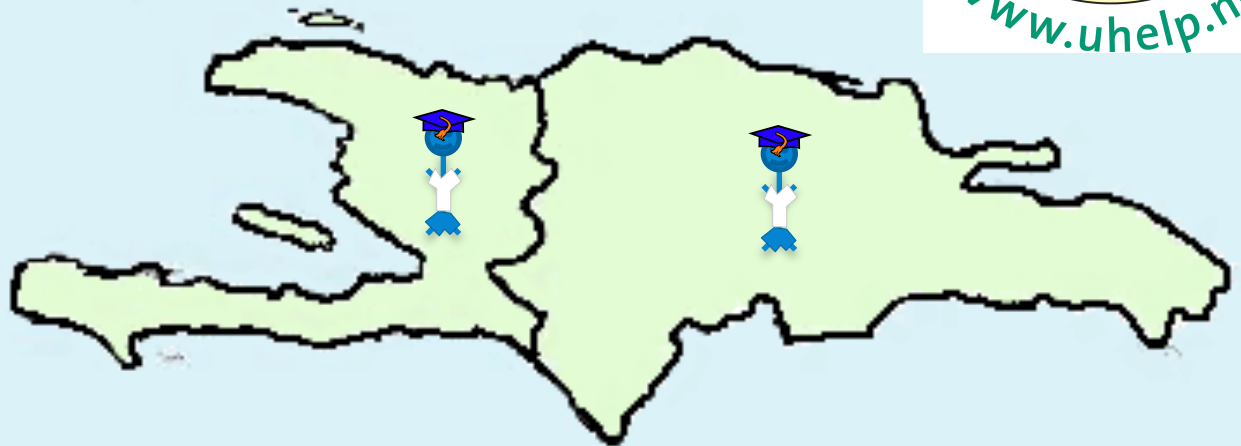
- Lack of educated workers is a principal constraint to progress.

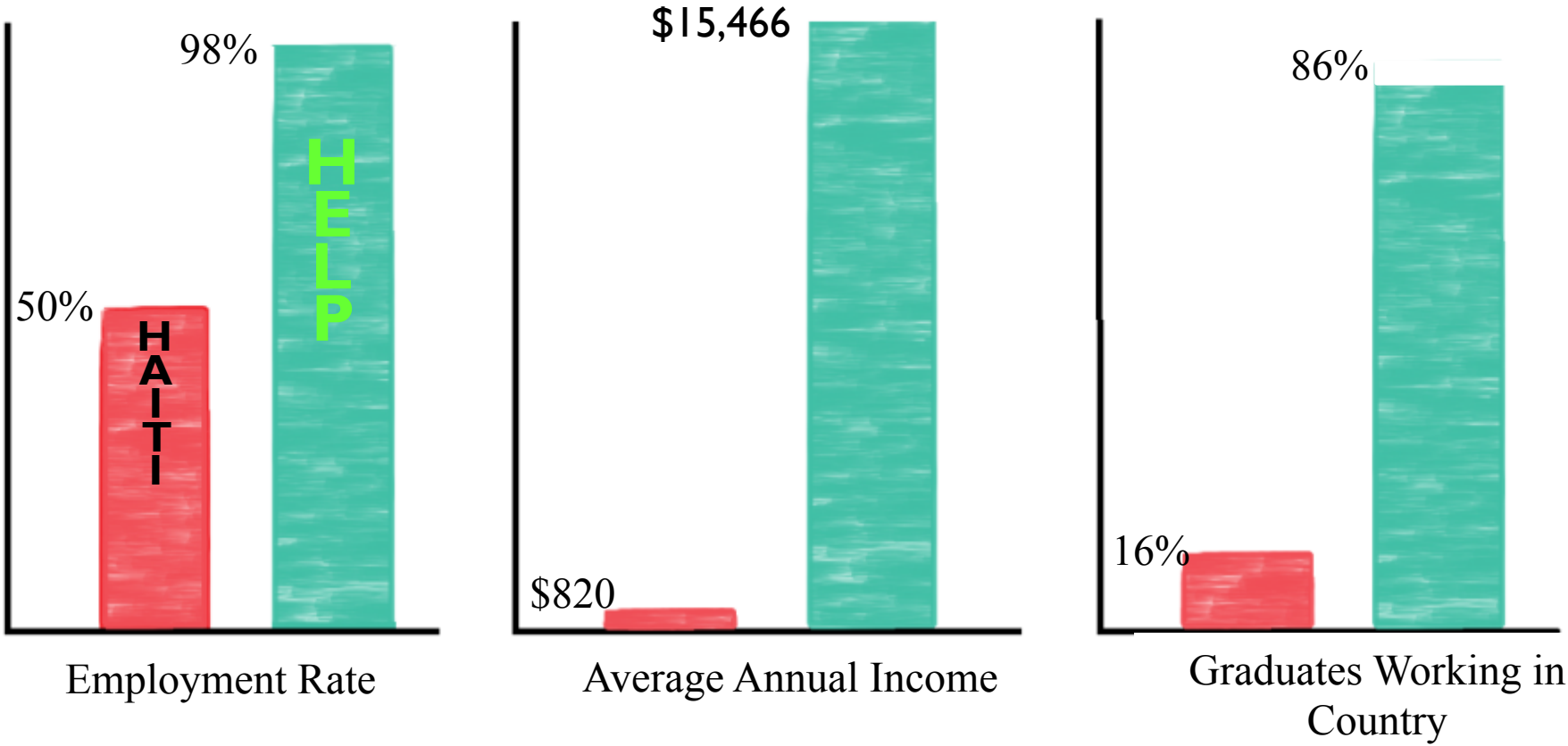

- **Stipend for transportation & food**



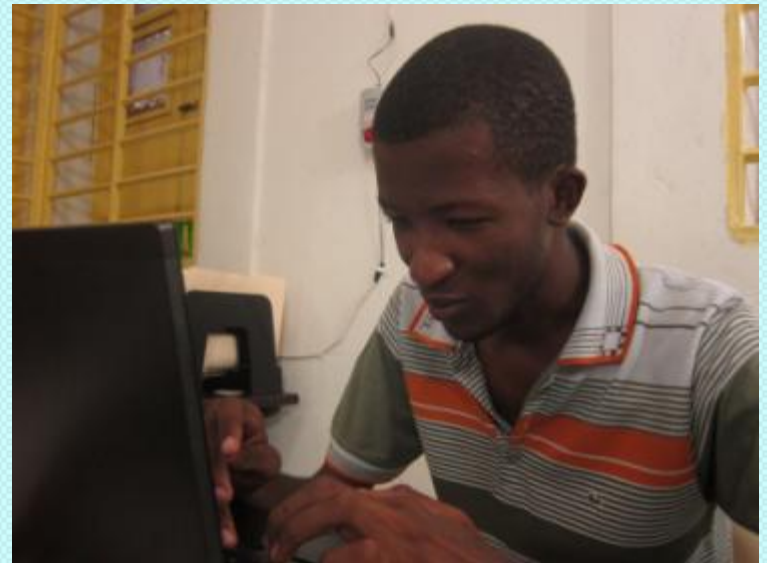
- Housing in HELP dorms

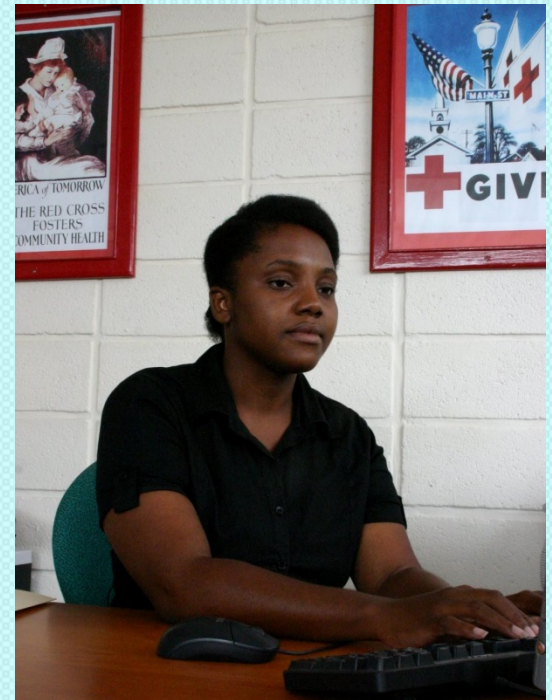
THEODULE JEAN-BAPTISTE

- Co-founder (with 2 other HELP students) and Executive Director of ACTIVEH, Haiti's first pan-university student organization
- ACTIVEH has created:
- over 60 internships annually for Haitian university students
- over 2,000 annual volunteer hours for university students.



SABRINA CYPRIEN

- Graduated in 2014 with a degree in Agronomy
- Attended summer session at Dartmouth College
- Pursuing her PhD in Agronomy in France in order to join the faculty at her alma mater



ELICE ORESTE

- Graduated in 2014: Industrial Engineering
- Maintenance Engineer at BRANA, Haiti's largest brewery.
- \$24,000 salary
- Started feeding program which serves 200 people monthly in his home town of Labiche



LOOKING AHEAD:

• HELP Campus

- In 2015 HELP purchased property with a grant from Artists for Haiti
- HELP has applied for grants to cover renovation & construction
- HELP Campus will house:
 - Classrooms
 - Offices
 - Computer lab
 - Meeting space
 - Library
 - Auditorium



- **Monitoring & Evaluations**

- In 2015 HELP Dare2Impact recommended ways to collect and analyze data on HELP's results on an ongoing basis.
- In 2016 HELP will conduct an assessment of the Citizenship & Leadership program to provide quantitative results to our donors as well as identifying potential areas of improvement.
