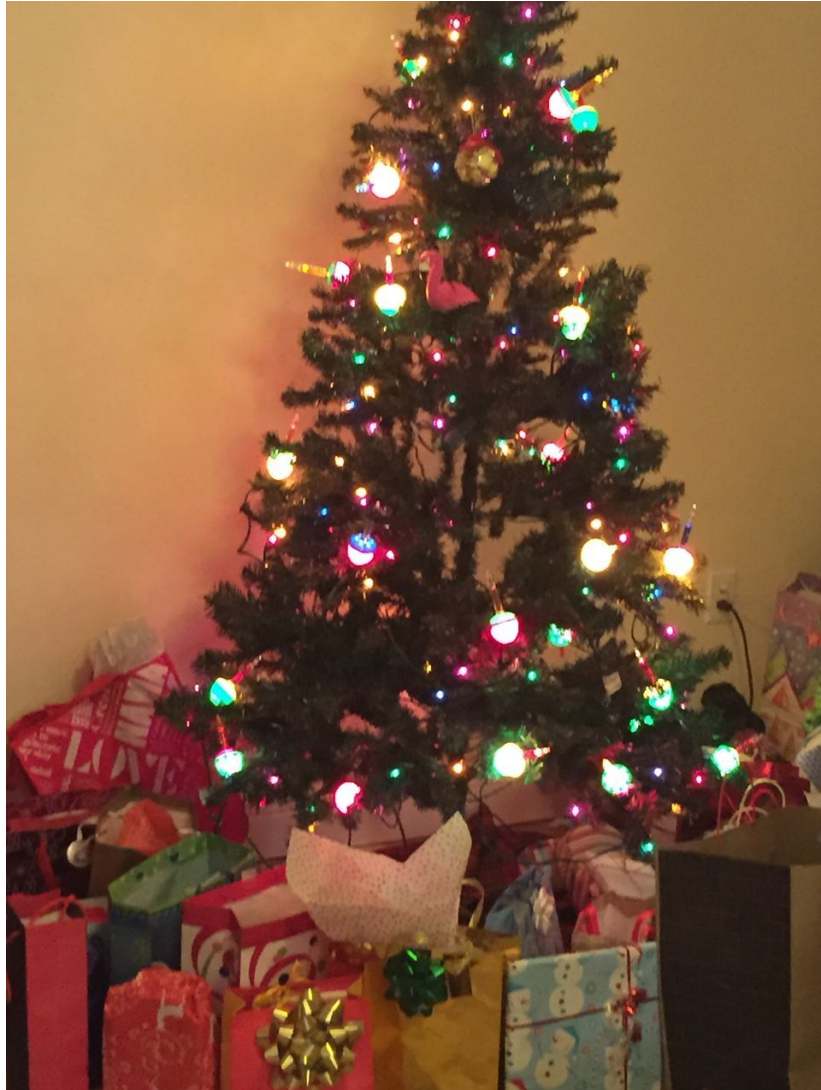

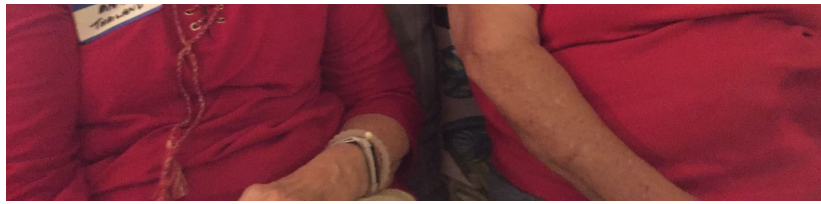
A good time was had by all, with the sharing of good food, laughter, fun gifts, and *Coquito*!

Coquito Recipe

1 12 oz. can evaporated milk

1 14 oz. can sweetened condensed milk

1 15 oz. can cream of coconut

1/4 tsp. cinnamon

1/8 tsp. nutmeg

1 tsp. vanilla

1 1/2 cup white rum

cinnamon sticks for garnish

Mix all the ingredients in a blender, refrigerate for one hour (minimum), and shake well before serving.

Store in an airtight container up to 4–6 months. If the coconut cream solidifies, let it sit for 10 minutes, shake, and enjoy! *Salud!*
