Take Action




Florida Senator **Rick Scott** has introduced a bill, <u>S.2320</u>, to make Peace Corps part of the U.S. Department of State. This proposal puts PCVs work and well-being at risk. Since its creation by President Kennedy in 1961, Peace Corps has been **intentionally apolitical**, not a foreign policy program. Folding Peace Corps into the State Department would change that, creating suspicion within countries where Peace Corps Volunteers serve, thereby **jeopardizing** the program and potentially putting Peace Corps Volunteers at **greater personal risk**.
